I have raised this matter with The Rt Hon Chris Grayling, Lord Chancellor and Secretary of State for Justice. I noted the contents of our discussion asking whether out of court settlements by definition, are usually referred to during the court's proceedings.

In addition, I have also raised this with Chief Constable Sara Thornton CBE QPM, Thames Valley Police. I noted your concerns and your comments about making a statement to the police. I have asked for her comments in regard to this.

I hope this will be of use and I will, of course, keep you informed of the response I receive.
