Dear Ms May,

You may recall that I wrote to you towards the end of last year. I eventually visited your surgery on 21st March and raised my concerns with you regarding a 7 figure out of court settlement which Mr Gilbert-Smith paid RBWM in relation to his paedophile activities at Green Field House.

In your letter of 26th March you told me; *"I have raised this matter with The Rt Hon Chris Grayling, asking whether out of court settlements by definition are usually referred to in the courts proceedings?"* On 17th May I received a letter from Charlotte Adams. Ms Adams enclosed a copy of the response from The Rt Hon Chris Grayling. After reading the Lord Chancellor's response, I understand his communication to say, that the matter is nothing to do with his office, but rather a matter for the CPS.

I fully accept what the Lord Chancellor has said in this letter (enclosed) but the two main points I raised with you have still not been addressed ie:

1. You raised the matter with Chief Constable Sara Thornton, concerning me making a statement to the police to instigate charges of the abuse I suffered at the hands of Gilbert-Smith, as there were no charges at the 2010 trial concerning my complaints. I would now like to have my complaint taken seriously and charges brought against Gilbert-Smith. (Could you please advise me on this?)
2. Lastly there is still the issue I raised with you concerning RBWM accepting payments from suspected paedophiles in return for RWBM entering a vow of secrecy with the suspected paedophile.

As my representative, I would like to ask you these two questions;

1. Do you have any concerns regarding the secret terms of RWBM's agreement with this suspected paedophile?
2. Is receiving money from suspected paedophiles and striking secret agreements with suspected paedophiles an appropriate way for RWBM to conduct themselves, especially after the then council swept the Green Field House child abuse under the carpet in 1970?

Mrs May as my representative can you please please please help us? Every kid in that Maidenhead children's home got raped and Gilbert-Smith raped around half of them. There is ample evidence for a conviction but ever since 1970 Gilbert-Smith has paid large sums of cash to avoid justice.

A letter from the Secretary of State for Justice saying that: **1. He can't comment 2. This is not his department but rather it is the department of the CPS**, is not very helpful. I don't wish to appear ungrateful because I believe your concern is genuine, but this really isn't very helpful.

Could you please, please really help?
